Many owners often prefer to have their pets put to sleep at home, and we are happy to accommodate this. In these situations both a vet and a nurse will attend the visit.

Following euthanasia, owners can take their pet for home burial, or leave them with us for cremation with a pet crematorium. Private cremation is also available for owners who would like their pet's ashes back, with a range of scatter boxes and caskets available.
